


# September Komework Week 1



#### **Investigating My Name**


Please have Mom and Dad help you finish answering these questions about your name. Don't forget to tell them about the story of "Chrysanthemum" and how she got her name.





Cut and glue the pictures for the correct sound.
























Please assist your child in learning to follow the text of a book from the top to the bottom of the page.

#### Using a book:

- \*Show your child the front of the book.
- \* Show your child the back of the book.
- \* Point to the title of the book as you read the title on the cover.
- \* Show your child the title page. Explain that this is where the title, author's name and where it was published is located.
- \* Look at the pictures on the cover.
- \* Point to where the story begins and where it ends.
- \* Read the book and point to each word as you read the story. Point out that we read from left to right.
